SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION GRANTED TO SHIP CATEGORY 1 QUANTITIES OF
COBALT-60, IRIIDIUM-192 AND SELENIUM-75 TO BELGIUM (PXB14a.08-C01)

Dear Ms. Richardt:

On May 2, 2016, Source Production and Equipment Corp., Inc. (SPEC) submitted a request to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to obtain government-to-government consent to export Category 1 quantities of cobalt-60 (Co-60), iridium-192 (Ir-192), and selenium-75 (Se-75) not to exceed two shipments per month and 200 TBq per shipment, to NTP Radioisotopes located in Fleurus, Belgium. On May 17, 2016, the NRC received a favorable response from the nuclear materials regulator in Belgium granting you authority to ship Category 1 quantities of Co-60, Ir-192, and Se-75, not to exceed two shipments per month and 200 TBq per shipment, to NTP Radioisotopes located in Fleurus, Belgium.

The NRC issued the license PXB14a.08 with conditions prohibiting SPEC from shipping 10 CFR Part 110 Appendix P Category 1 quantities of Co-60, Ir-192, and Se-75 until: 1) SPEC has requested the NRC in writing to obtain specific consent from the importing country's regulatory authority, on a case-by-case basis; 2) NRC has considered government-to-government consent pursuant to 10 CFR §110.42(e)(3); and, 3) NRC has informed SPEC in writing, that it is authorized to ship the materials to the recipient(s) specified.

Therefore, the conditions necessary to ship to NTP Radioisotopes have been met and you are authorized to make Co-60, Ir-192, and Se-75 shipments as authorized in PXB14a.08 and this authorization. This authorization expires on February 3, 2019.
